

Burgate Manor is near Fordingbridge in Hampshire. It is around 11 miles south of Salisbury on the A338. To find us please see directions below:

- **By public transport:** The nearest station is Salisbury (1 hour 30 minutes from Waterloo). Taxi fare to Fordingbridge is about £22 and takes around 20 minutes. Taxis wait outside the station, but private hire taxis can be pre-booked by calling City Cabs on 01722 423000 or Value Cars on 01722 5050505. There is a good bus service (X3) that usually runs every 30 minutes from Salisbury bus station to Fordingbridge. For the bus timetable visit [.wdbus.co.uk](http://wdbus.co.uk). Get off the bus opposite the post office in Fordingbridge. Stay on the same side of the road you got off and walk back the way the bus just came for a few hundred yards. Just past a Chinese takeaway you will see a car park with retirement flats on your right. Walk into the car park and you will see a footpath on the right that leads down to the river and under the A338. Follow this footpath and it will lead you under the bridge and up to the entrance for the Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust.
- **By car from the North:** On the A338 go through the small hamlet of Breamore – this is a 30mph zone. You will pass the Tudor Rose pub and also the turning to Fordingbridge both on your right. Carry on a few hundred yards and the turning to Burgate Manor is on the left just before the bridge over the River Avon. There is a sign on the grass verge by the turning. You will have to be prepared, as the turning is soon after the lay-by and traffic moves quite quickly.
- **From the South:** Leave Ringwood northbound on the A338 Salisbury Road for around ten minutes. Go past the first turn-off to Fordingbridge on the left, then immediately after the bridge over the River Avon turn right into our drive just before our sign post. Take care – there is fast oncoming traffic. (If you reach the Tudor Rose pub you have gone too far).
- **From the East:** Continue on the M27 where it changes into the A31. Stay on the A31 until you get to Ringwood where you need to take the 3rd exit on the roundabout towards Fordingbridge on the A338 Salisbury Road. Go past the first turn-off to Fordingbridge on the left, then immediately after the bridge over the River Avon turn right into our drive just before our sign post. Take care – there is fast oncoming traffic. (If you reach the Tudor Rose pub you have gone too far).
- **From the West:** Enter the village of Cranborne either from Sixpenny Handley on the B3081 which then joins to the B3078, or from Wimborne Minster on the B3078. Stay on the B3078 and pass through Alderholt and keep heading towards the centre of Fordingbridge. You will come to a mini roundabout with a turning off towards Salisbury and the A338 on the Salisbury Road. Take this turning towards Salisbury and keep going until you reach the A338. Make sure you take the right slip road to enable you to turn right onto the A338 to approach us from the North. Once on the A338, there will be a left bend in the road ahead just after a left hand lay by. Our turning is just before the bridge over the River Avon. There is a sign on the grass verge by the turning. You will have to be prepared, as the turning is soon after the lay-by and traffic moves quite quickly.
