

## The Allerton Project at Loddington

The Allerton Project is in the village of Loddington, on the Leicestershire/Rutland border just off the A47 between Leicester and Peterborough.

**By public transport:** the nearest train station is Oakham, Rutland (7 miles), change at Leicester or Peterborough for trains which run hourly to Oakham. Market Harborough train station (23 miles), is on a direct line from St Pancras, London. Taxis are available outside both of these stations but can be costly, there are no regular bus services going through Loddington.

**By car:** from the A47 turn off at East Norton and follow the road bearing left through the village, please take care as the road narrows to a single carriageway and there are some sharp bends. Once at Loddington, turn right at the T-junction for Manor Farm Visitor Centre and Hall Farm, or left for Loddington House.

Please note there is another Loddington, near Kettering in Northamptonshire.
