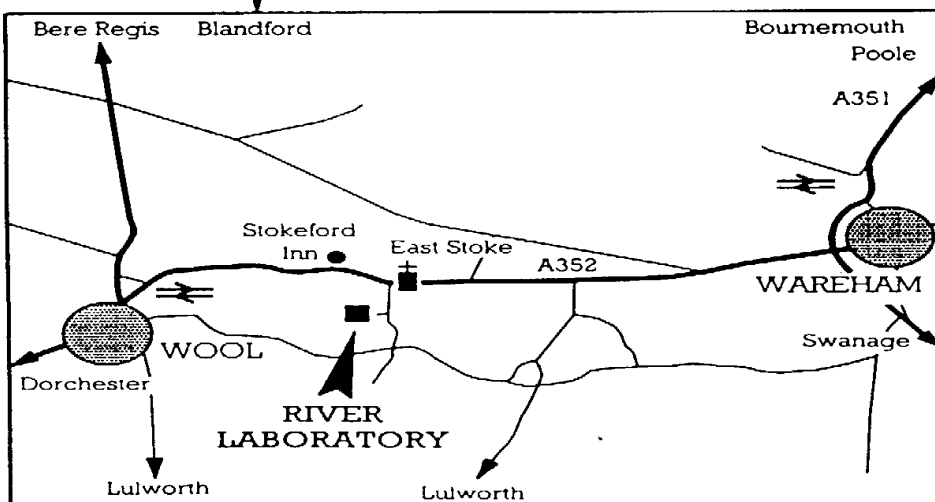
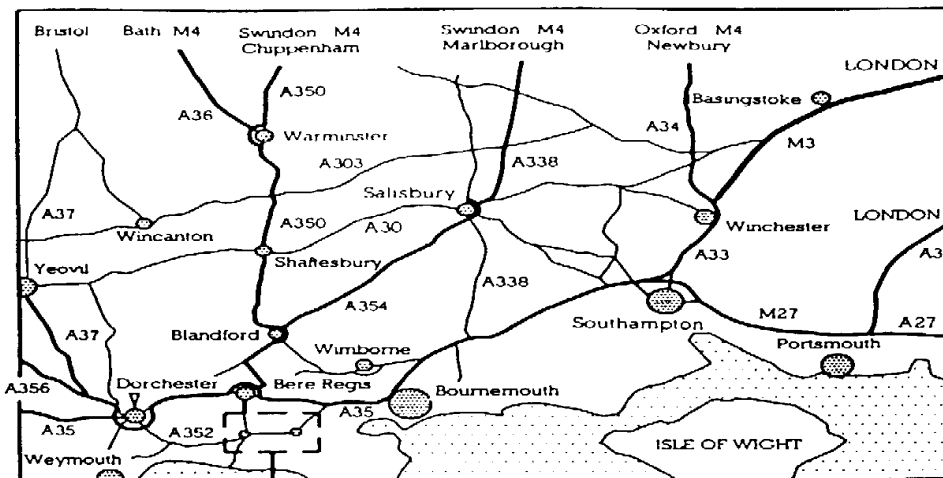

barrier is down, wait for a member of the railway staff to open it) and cross the River Frome. The River Laboratory is the first turn on the right.

**RAIL:** South West trains from London Waterloo to Wool (approx. 2¼ hours) run about 15 trains a day (weekdays). Be sure to join the Weymouth (front) part of the train at Waterloo. Wool station is 2¼ miles (3.5km) from the River Laboratory.

There is an infrequent service from Bristol to Dorchester West and Weymouth. From Dorchester South (500 metres from Dorchester West), trains run to Wool.

**BUS:** The National Express coach network has stops in Poole and Dorchester. This service can be useful for journeys from the west where rail connections are poor.
