CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME

It is with immense pleasure that we, the Committee and the Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust, thank you for coming tonight for our 40th Anniversary London Ball.

The GWCT began life in the 1930's and since then has gone from strength to strength. As some of you will know, the scientific research carried out by the Trust goes much further than just game conservation. The GWCT advises farmers and landowners on improving wildlife habitat and advocates for agricultural and conservation policies based on science. From bees, birds and butterflies, to farmland, moorland, rivers and wetland; all are influenced by the Trust's vital work which aims for a thriving countryside rich in game and other wildlife.

A year ago, I wrote that there had never been a more vital time for people to show their commitment to the cause. It was true then, regrettably it is even more true now. The two central tenets of the GWCT are that land managed for game delivers benefits for wildlife more widely, and that if you want to have a real effect, you need to work at landscape scale. The former has been proven and demonstrated time and time again, the latter is best exemplified by GWCT-inspired Farmer Clusters. In these, a group of farmers come together, decide what wildlife they would like to see more of, then do something about it. There are more than half-a-million hectares of Farmer Clusters in England, with more coming onboard the whole time. Those who oppose all of this would have us believe there is no benefit, ignoring the fact that if

no-one pursued game in this country, we'd likely have fewer waders, fewer hedgerows, fewer people planting trees, fewer songbirds and overall, less biodiversity in our countryside. Inconvenient truths indeed.

DIRECTOR'S CUT

Mysteries, problems and solutions, these are our stock in trade. We were founded to find out why grey partridge numbers crashed in the 1930s and have been at it ever since. Coming right up to date, our SAMARCH project is solving the mystery of what happens to sea trout at sea (early answer, they dive much deeper, more often, and so are more vulnerable to netting than previously understood!). In between we have found out where woodcock come from and go to, how to rid an entire river course of invasive American mink, and at our farm – the Allerton Project, in Leicestershire - have shown how to greatly increase farmland bird numbers. But crucially we have an advisory team that helps landowners and land managers use the science on the ground – it's practical, not theoretical.

I can see from previous Ball brochures that challenges and threats are a consistent theme. David mentions this in his Welcome, but what's going on currently feels different to anything that has gone before, and that's according to one of my colleagues who has been with GWCT 44 years! Years ago, our mantra was 'We produce the bullets for other people to fire', meaning we did the science, and in the main others made use of it. We have come a long way since then and whilst the science is as important as ever, we have significantly dialled

up the policy and communications work.

The key thing for us, as for many charities (not all, some household names earn large proportions of their income from contracts), is that our output is directly proportional to your input, as roughly three quarters of our income is voluntary - someone has to decide to give it.

So if you want us to keep producing the science, making the case, challenging the tosh produced by some prominent people and organisations, do please put your hand up one extra time in the Main Auction, buy one more item than you really need in the Silent Auction, or simply join as a member. Support for GWCT is support for the future of the British countryside.

2. **Purchasers must take the sport being offered on the dates stated or subsequently agreed otherwise they will forfeit the purchased lots. All fishing and stalking will be 2020 and shooting will be during 2020-2021 season unless otherwise stated.**
3. GWCT Auction lots are usually sold with an expected bag size. Any significant increase on this number should be agreed between the buyer and the donor on terms acceptable to the donor.
4. Any statement as to authorship, attribution, origin, date, age, provenance and conditions is a statement of opinion, and is not to be taken as a statement or representation of fact.
5. The highest bidder shall be the buyer. If any dispute arises the auctioneer shall have the absolute discretion to settle it and to put any disputed lot up again. The auctioneer acts as agent only. He shall have full discretion to refuse any bidding, to divide any lot, to combine any two or more lots and to withdraw any lot or lots from the sale without in any case giving reason.
