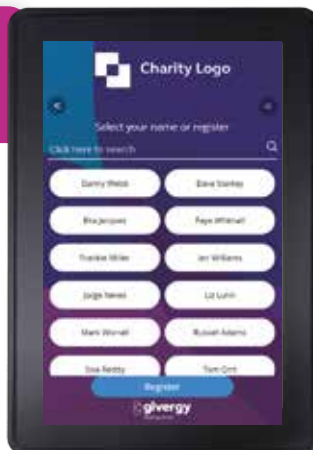

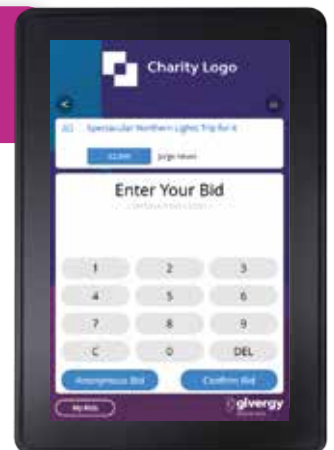

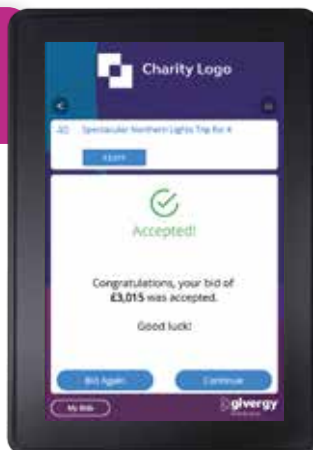

Chairman's Welcome

I bid you all a very warm welcome to the seventh annual West of Scotland Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust Dinner. Last year we broke all records raising nearly £90,000 for the GWCT all of which was spent in Scotland. The feedback which I received after the dinner was that it was a great night and thoroughly enjoyed by everyone. May this year's Dinner be even better in all respects.

For those of you who do not really know what the GWCT is or stands for, it is a research-based and knowledge-based charity helping to inform, educate and advise on the best land management practices. It has, for many years, influenced Government Policy and assisted farmers and landowners (including Community buy-outs) on how best to provide a thriving countryside rich in game and wildlife for which Scotland is renowned world-wide. It both deserves and needs your support.

There are few, if any, Reporting Bodies which could affect our sport on which it does not have significant representation. It has the ear of the decision makers.

The GWCT was a significant signatory to the Joint Statement by Countryside Organisations issued recently on the phasing out over the next five years of the use of lead shot and the single use, non-recyclable plastic in cartridge manufacture and the introduction of genuinely bio-degradable starch wads which will enable us to use steel shot without causing irreparable damage to our shot guns.

I am tempted to invite the assembled company to all stand up and then to invite members of the GWCT to sit down but the result for all to see would be embarrassing as it would be more than half of tonight's diners who would be left standing.

Jamie Daniell from the GWCT is present here tonight and he will be very happy to organise membership for those who would have been left standing! You are perhaps fortunate that Rob Wainwright and Al Kellock, both of whom are supporters, are not here tonight otherwise they could well have been tasked with the job!

Membership is not expensive. The tip for the keeper on a 200-bird day would more than cover joint membership for husband and wife and it qualifies for Gift Aid. For those who are not

members I would urge you to support the GWCT by becoming members. HMRC will be adding an additional 25% to your subscription if you Gift Aid it!

The dinner tonight would not happen without the generous support of our Sponsors – Dawn, R K Harrison, Graham MacKinlay and Co. and Turcan Connell, the free spirited support of Kinrara Gin who laid on the gin reception, Kenny Mackay who sourced and provided after-dinner drinks for every table, Graham's Family Dairy who not only provided the butter and ice-cream but put up a year's supply of yoghurt for the auction and Laings, the jewellers, for sponsoring the raffle. 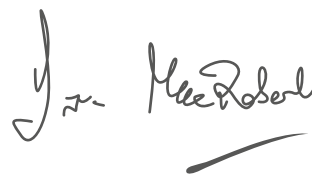

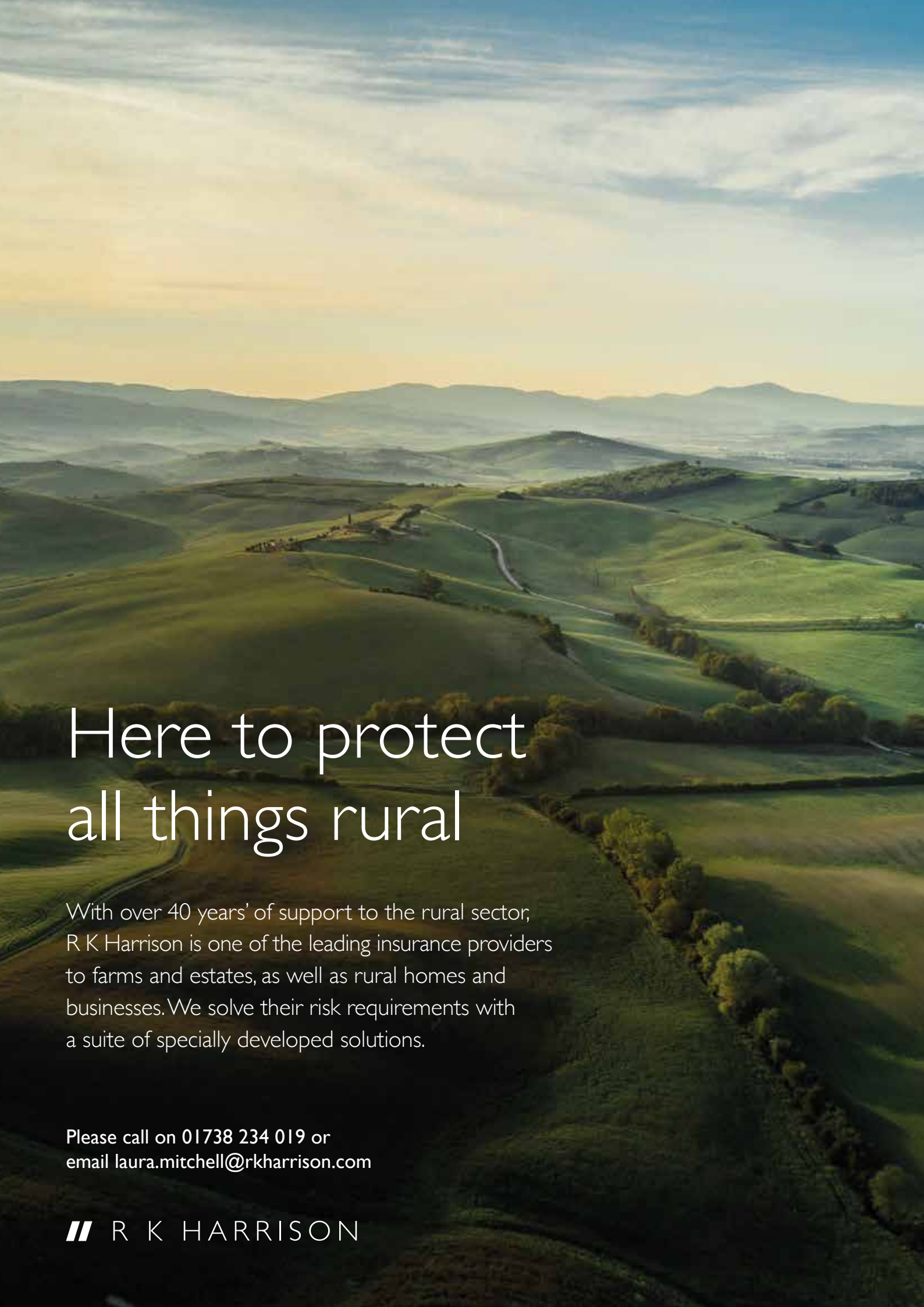

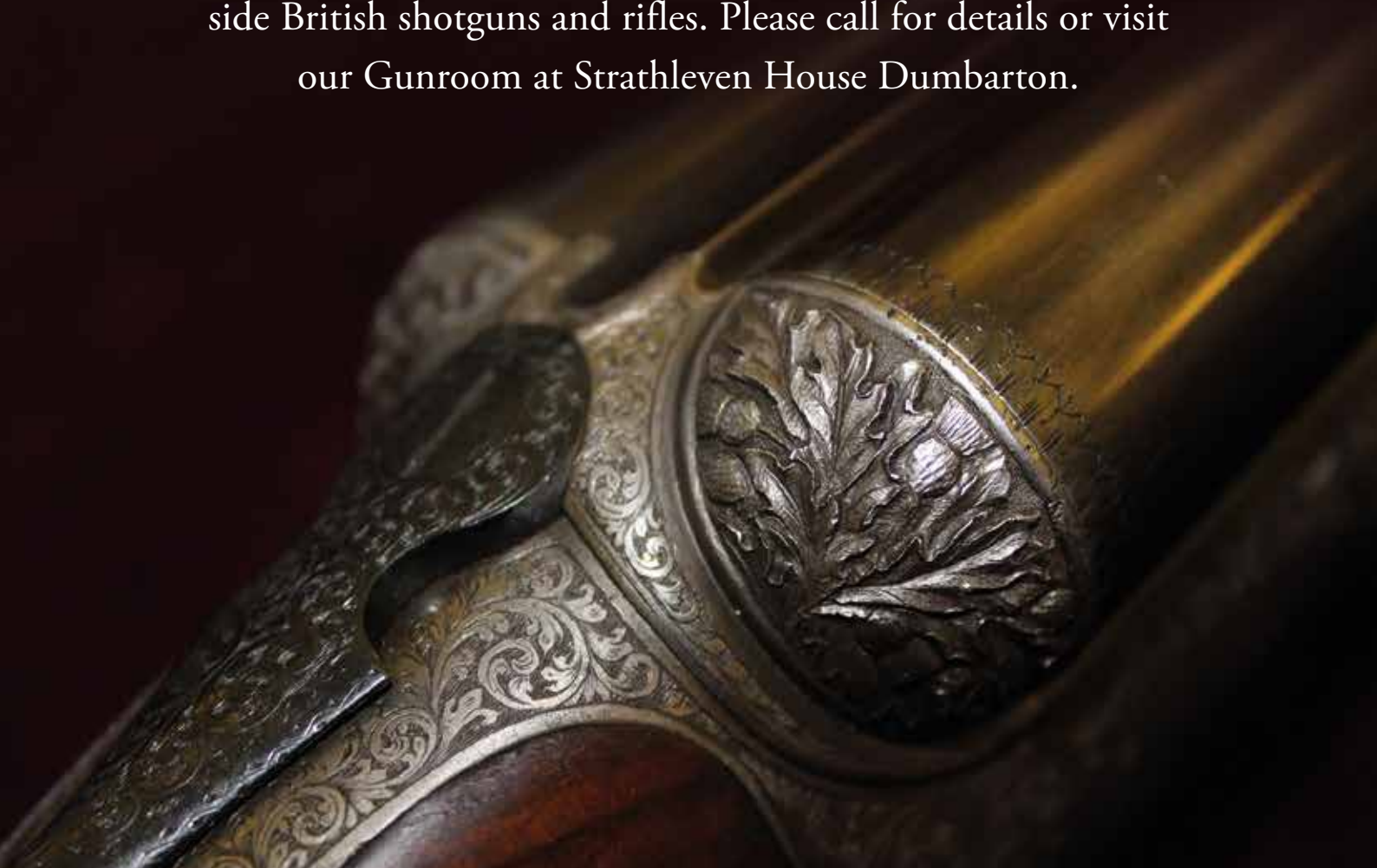

The Committee urge you to help them maximise funds generated by their auction for the Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust in this way. This is at no additional cost to yourself, and if you are a higher rate taxpayer you may be able to claim further tax relief via your self-assessment tax return of a further 25% of the difference.



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Information and conditions of sale

1. Purchasers must take the sport being offered on the dates stated or subsequently agreed otherwise they will forfeit the purchased lots. All shooting, fishing and stalking will be 2020/21 unless otherwise stated. Rollovers into subsequent years are not permitted unless otherwise stated.
