

CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you all to this the 31st annual GWCT Scottish Auction and Dinner. What began as a modest gathering all those years ago has become a firm favourite in the diaries of many, and, thanks to all who have supported it, raised in excess of £2.9m. With your help this year let's raise that figure to over £3m.

The trust is an apolitical body committed to the preservation of species and philosophy. Detailed research is committed to interrogating rural issues, from brown hares to grey partridges, grouse welfare to curlew populations, investigatory initiatives unique to the conservation cause. That is not to detract from the excellent work carried out by other organisations but their objectives are often more focussed on the activities of participating individuals rather than scientific assessments. There is, of course, a symbiotic co-operation with common goals but the GWCT's brief is perhaps more widely embracing than simply being dedicated to what, in Victorian times, might have been described as sporting prey species.

Funding is always an issue. The pie chart in this catalogue details the income sources and financial outflowings of the organisation. While those of us who shoot, fish, stalk or simply enjoy the bucolic idyll have many high profile opportunities to support these activities through monetary contributions, the GWCT has no such avenues save for events such as tonight's dinner and other comparable efforts around the country including the Scottish Game Fair at Scone to whose attendance in July I commend you. That is why your presence here tonight is so important along with the extraordinary generosity of our lot donors, sponsors and cash donors. Membership of the GWCT is still very disappointing. Perhaps it is not seen as a voice for rural affairs but without its work our countryside, already under threat from the prejudiced and ill-informed, will remain under siege.

Obviously I hope you enjoy the evening, supported by Prestonfield and its excellent staff, but please acknowledge the Trust's work with clink of coin, the rustle of notes or the click of an e-transfer to enable the GWCT to continue its excellent research work.





THE DIRECTOR'S CUT

I am delighted to welcome both regular and new attendees to the Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust's Prestonfield Auction 2019. This long standing event for the Trust in support of countryside conservation is the result of a great deal of hard work by the Auction's committee. As the new Director Scotland for the Trust I am delighted to take this opportunity to thank Bryan Johnston, the committee chairman, for all he has done over the last 4 years.

I have started working with the Trust at a time when there are many challenges and opportunities for game and wildlife in Scotland. It will be my role to ensure that the Trust's work in these areas is supported and developed, both financially and by 'spreading the word'.

It has been fascinating to begin to understand better the breadth and depth of the work undertaken by the Trust. I am clear on the importance of Auchnerran, our farm on Deeside, as a means for demonstrating how to achieve a thriving countryside rich in game and wildlife. A visit to Auchnerran is special and informative and we would like to see many more visitors. Perhaps you might visit this year if you are the successful bidder on the sport we are offering at the farm this evening at Lots 1 and 11.

The GWCT Scottish Game Fair is another high profile event for game conservation in Scotland. Running over the 5th to the 7th of July this year at Scone Palace, the Fair will have a heather moorland theme. This recognises that the focus of much of the Trust's work in 2018 has been on the uplands, and that this will continue in 2019.

Threats to our sporting culture and management are too often starting in the uplands, so the Trust has supported the moorland keepers and owners who not only deliver great sport, but also globally important conservation. We helped deliver the first of a new kind of licence aimed at reducing predator impacts on curlew, improved advice on the control of sheep ticks, and proved that combining hill farming and keeping can produce a nationally important population of lapwings.

Scotland's countryside needs to produce food, grow timber and provide recreation opportunities, but as a result shooting, stalking, fishing and wildlife are being increasingly squeezed. I am greatly looking forward to working for the organisation which is dedicated to researching and delivering knowledge, practice and policy to reduce and reverse that squeeze.

Your attendance tonight means that our charity will continue to be able to promote the need for game conservation and wildlife management in our countryside. Thank you, and enjoy your evening.
