
#### Did you know?

In the winter, there is often less food for farmland birds, as fields have been ploughed and there is less to eat. This is called the hungry gap. Farmers and gamekeepers help by growing crops that give birds the seeds they need at this time and by scattering seed on the ground for them to eat.



### The three-legged stool


You might have seen one of these on a farm. We use it to describe the three important things birds need to help them to grow.










You will find me in gardens. I like to drink nectar from flowers such as bluebells. Have fun colouring me in.




### LIFECYCLE OF THE ATLANTIC SALMON
