



How to place a bid




1. Visit the Fundraising Site

Scan the QR code provided, enter the URL into your smart phone browser or click the link in the email / SMS you receive.




2. Browse the Items

Browse through the items available. For more information and images of each item simply tap on the item.




3. Sign In / Register

Once you've found an item you'd like to bid on, you'll be asked to **Sign In**. Simply follow the steps to create an account.




4. Place Your Bid

Chairman's Welcome

I bid you all a very warm welcome to the twelfth West of Scotland GWCT Dinner. I hope that you have all enjoyed the Kinrara gin reception and oyster's downstairs. Last year the feedback which I received after the dinner was that it was a great night and thoroughly enjoyed by everyone. Your generosity last year resulted in our raising just under £100,000 for GWCT all of which is or was spent in Scotland. I understand that this is the funding for additional research posts. May this year's Dinner be even better in all respects. The Committee have thought out of the box this year and have come up with many new and novel lots for the auctions which I hope will be hard fought over to maximise the income produced for GWCT. A few of the auction lots could well frighten the living daylight out of some of you.

For those of you who do not really know what GWCT is or stands for, it is a research based and knowledge-based charity helping to inform, educate and advise on the best land management practices. It has, for many years, influenced Government Policy and assisted farmers and landowners (including Community Buy-outs) on how best to provide a thriving countryside rich in game and wildlife for which Scotland is renowned world-wide. It both deserves and needs your support as it has our rural sports and indeed the whole rural community and rural economy at its heart.

There are few, if any, Reporting Bodies which could affect our sport on which GWCT does not have significant representation. It has the ear of the decision makers which in this day and age is so important.

Those of us who enjoy rural sports are under constant and increasing threat from all sides and GWCT will do whatever it can to preserve our sports, but it needs the necessary support from us both on fundraising and subscriptions.

GWCT has made, and continues to make, informed and respected representations on Grouse moor licencing, Muirburn, Hunting with dogs, Snaring, Deer legislation, Land Reform, Capercaillie, Natural Capital and many other topics all of which have a bearing on not only our sporting interests but the rural economy as a whole and for that we should be grateful and supportive of GWCT. Unfortunately, not all the representations are well received and are ignored.

GWCT has a membership of approximately 20,000. That would be good if that was the Scottish number but that is the World -wide number and Scotland has a below average membership level.

Karen Raine from GWCT is present here tonight and she will be very happy to organise membership for those who feel that now is the time to join. It is never too late.

Membership is not expensive. The tip for the keeper on a 200 bird day would more than cover joint membership for husband and wife and it qualifies for Gift Aid. For those who are not members I would urge you to support GWCT by becoming members. HMRC will be adding an additional 25% to your subscription if you Gift Aid it!

For those of us who shoot the participation in sweepstakes is a useful and relatively painless way of raising additional funds for GWCT and I would encourage participation.

I am delighted that Dr Nick Hesford, Director Scotland for GWCT is at my table. Nick has been responsible for driving forward our innovative use of technology in supporting traditional game management.

Sadly, we no longer have the fillets of beef to carve at the tables which is probably a relief to a few table hosts, but it would be wrong not to acknowledge the huge support of Robbie Galloway and Scotbeef for the dinner over many years. Thank-you Robbie.

However, we are very lucky that Christian Nissen from Highland Game has very generously donated the venison for this evening's meal. Highland Game support GWCT Scotland across their three largest events for which we are all very grateful.

We are also very appreciative of the support of Ayr Racecourse who are this year's event sponsor. They also host Scotland's biggest and richest flat racing festive, The Ladbrokes Ayr Gold Cup which is held between 17th and 19th September. It's always a fantastic day out and I would urge you to attend if get the chance.

The dinner tonight would not be what it is without the generous free-spirited support of Kinrara Gin who

laid on the gin reception, Chrystal's Shortbread and Laings who are sponsoring the prize draw. I am extremely grateful to them all for their invaluable assistance. We are also delighted that Taylor's Port are supporting us this year with delicious late bottle vintage 2020 port to enjoy with your cheese.

We have well over 100 lots in the auctions and there is something for everyone as it is so varied. The lot providers have been incredibly generous and I cannot thank them enough. Next year we expect to be able to have the dinner at the newly re-furbished North Rotunda, courtesy of Donald Stewart who is on the Committee and is here tonight. It will be an exciting move.

My final thanks are to you for coming to this dinner and supporting our fundraising efforts for GWCT so please enjoy the night and dig deep and bid generously in the auctions to match the generosity of the lot providers.

Silent Auction

It may be beneficial from a tax perspective for auction lots to be sold on behalf of the providers of the lots and although they will be given 21 days in which to ask for the proceeds of sale to be sent to them it is believed that they will not do so and by not so doing that they will gift the proceeds to GWCT under Gift Aid thus adding 25% to the hammer proceeds. For this reason most of the lots are in fact being sold for the providers of the lots.

Gift Aid

Where the successful bid exceeds the known reasonable market value of the Lot, the purchaser, by signing a Gift Aid Declaration (you must be a UK taxpayer and have tax paid or payable equivalent to the relief being claimed), will be able to enhance the value of their donation. Gift Aid allows the Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust, being a Charity, to claim an additional 25% on the difference between the market value and the winning bid. The Committee urge you to help them maximise funds generated by their auction for the Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust in this way.

This is at no additional cost to yourself, and if you are a higher rate taxpayer you may be able to claim further tax relief via your self-assessment tax return on 125% of the difference.

- On-site checks of release pens, bird welfare and habitats.
- A clear and comprehensive report with practical recommendations and a sustainability score.

Gamebird Release Assessments are intended to be repeated on an annual basis in order to document how recommendations are implemented over time. If combined with GWCT Predator Control Assessments, they form part of a vital paper trail that demonstrates uncompromising commitment to due diligence and best practice.
